



International Transfer Card from Hockey Canada

Please be advised that Hockey Canada is very willing to co-operate in the processing of transfer cards that will allow CANADIAN players to play for your Federation.

However, please be aware that upon our issuing a transfer card on behalf of the specific player to your club, you are agreeing to the IIHF rules and regulations outlined in the International Transfer Regulations section 11 (Release of a Player for National Team Games) of Part I of the IIHF International Transfer Regulations.

It is imperative that club teams understand that Hockey Canada may select players from any team and it is the club's responsibility to release the player. The club team is obligated to do so as outlined in the IIHF Rules and Regulations in International Transfers.

11.1 Any club that has registered a player who is eligible under IIHF By-Laws to play for the national team of a member national association must, in the event that he is selected for one of its representative teams, release him to the member national association for which team he is eligible to play, irrespective of age and in accordance with the IIHF International Transfer Regulations, which in this respect includes all players whether transferred or not.

11.6 Any player registered with a club is obliged to respond affirmatively when called upon by the selecting national association to play for one of its representative teams.

NOTE to 11.1 Representatives teams are defined as any official Hockey Canada National Team programs such as but not limited to Canada's National Team participation in annual Spengler Cup, Deutschland Cup and World Championship tournaments.

Hockey Canada will provide medical and health care insurance during the period which the player is with the national team. Hockey Canada does not insure the value of the player's contract with his club team. By executing this document, the player's club team acknowledges its responsibility for providing such insurance to the player against any injury he may sustain during any national team activity

Hockey Canada has adopted a policy regarding the issuing of International Transfer Cards. Prior to issuing the player card, the respective club and player must sign this document stating that they fully understand that the respective player will be made available to Canada at any time that the player may be required to play for Canada's National Team.
