



## 1. International Stuttgart Junior - Tournament 2009 April, 17th 2009 to April, 19th 2009

### Rules and Regulations

**1. Organisation and Location:** **Stuttgarter Eishockeyclub e.V.**  
Eissportzentrum Waldau, Kesslerweg 8, 70597 Stuttgart

#### **2. Participants, Games and Schedules**

In total 8 teams will play in 2 groups with 4 teams each. In a group each team plays ones against each other. The Semi-final will be crossover games between the 1st and 2nd place, the first of group 1 will play the second of group 2 and the second of group 1 will play the first of group 2. The two winning teams of the Semi final will play the Final Game. The other two teams will play for 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The third of group 1 will play the fourth of group 2 and the fourth of group 1 will play the third of group 2. The two winning teams will play for 5<sup>th</sup> place after that. The games will be on Saturday April 17<sup>th</sup> and Sunday April 18<sup>th</sup> according to the attached schedule.

#### **Point award:**

3 points for a win, 2 points for a win after penalty shooting, 1 point losing after penalty shooting.

#### **3. Rules**

The Games will be played according to the DEB rules and regulations and the current official rules of the IIHF (International Ice Hockey Federation).

Exception: Change of players on the fly.

#### **4. Penalties**

Minor penalties will be treated with an immediate penalty shot. The Penalty Shot shall be taken in a simplified manner and shall be performed by a player on the ice at the time of the penalty. Except the shooting player all other players will be next to the players benches near the red line. After the Penalty the game will continue normally or with bully at the centre ice spot. Details will be explained during a briefing with the coaches prior to the start of the tournament.

#### **5. Equal number of points**

In the event of equal points after the games, the team with the highest number of achieved goals will be winner. In case of equal goals, the total number of goals according to the subtraction method is relevant.

## 6. Entitled to play

Entitled to play are Children born 1997 and younger Art. 51 DEB-SpO. All players must be recognized by their local hockey association. Valid player card/passes and/or team rosters are necessary.

## 7. Teams

There is a minimum of 1 goalkeeper and 10 players per team. The maximum to sign in is 2 goalkeepers and 15 players. Each team will be requested to have 2 sets of jerseys (2 colours).

## 8. Duration of a game

Group games: 2 x 15 minutes without break (If the game is tied, penalty shooting will be performed accord. IIHF-Rules)

Warm up: 5 minutes prior to the game.

## 9. Arrival

Arrival date is Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2009, 1 day prior to start of games.

## 10. Accommodations and food

Accommodations for players, coach (1) and mangers (2) will be provided in gyms nearby the arena. The fee will be xx,xx € each.

Required are sleeping bags and inflatable mattresses if possible.

The team members will receive a breakfast and a meal on both days. The fee will be xx,xx € each.
